Wimpy's Wobble Shoots

Registered Wobble Shoots for 2006

St. Charles will enter its third year in offering Registered Wobble Trap Events. We are scheduling four registered Wobble Shoots for this season and planning to host Illinois State Wobble Shoot in August. We had a successful second year, with 12 to 20 participants at each shoot and most importantly a good time.

Wobble Trap is a "poor mans" International Trap where targets come out at a much greater angles and different heights than normal trap targets. A round consists of 25 targets and is shot in the same manner as typical trap. Shooters shoot from the 16 yard line, one shell per target. The target is thrown within 2 seconds of the shooters call for the target. This is a lot of fun and a good challenge for all shooters. I firmly believe it will make you a better trap shooter and improve your concentration.

We need at least five people to participate in these events to make them official registered shoots and shooters need to register 200 targets to be able to participate in the Illinois State Shoot. To be eligible you need to be a member of the Wimpy's Wobble Trap Association. Annual Dues are \$15.00 payable at the event. Our scheduled shoot dates are April 23rd, May 7th, and June 11th. The Illinois State Shoot is scheduled for August 13th. Registration for all shoots will begin at 9:00 a.m. and events will begin at 9:30 a.m. All Registrations will close at 10:30 a.m. Each event will consist of 100 targets. Special Notice to Members

Illegal Calibers Found

There have been illegal caliber shells found at the Rifle/Pistol range. This is an ongoing problem which has forced the Board to take action. Any illegal caliber shell that is found at the range in the future shall force the closure of the Rifle/Pistol Range for 30 days. Know the rules! Any caliber handgun (NO MAGNUM LOADS) and only rimfire and black powder rifles are allowed. Members, if you see someone using illegal loads please tell them to stop and/or report the violation to the Board.
